Dear Spring Creek (SC) Residents,

SC HOA Board is committed to working with and following the guidelines of the Greene County Health Department (GCHD) regarding COVID-19. We appreciate your patience during these unprecedented times and please know the SC Board wants you to have a safe summer at the pool.

The CDC has officially stated there is no evidence the COVID-19 can be spread to humans through the use of pools. Proper operation, maintenance, and disinfection of pools should remove or inactivate the virus that causes COVID-19. The SC Board is adopting procedures & protocols in an effort to follow GCHD guidelines for COVID-19's Road to Recovery in the 417 area. Please understand that this is a situation that can change daily or weekly according to the announcements of the Greene County Health Department. The SC Board is monitoring communications and will act accordingly.

Our pool will be opening soon. When it does, the following rules and changes will be implemented:

- Guests will not be admitted to the pool without being accompanied by a Spring Creek Resident. This includes extended family that does not reside in Spring Creek.
- Limited Occupancy: Swimming pool occupancy is limited to 25% of the bather load of the pool. The square footage of the Spring Creek pool and deck area will allow up to 70 people at the same time.
- The Pool will open at 11 AM and close at 9 PM daily
- New Check-In Procedures: All Residence will be required to check in manually into the pool. Names, address and contact information will be required at time of entry. This is an essential component of ensuring operational safety and the ability to report to the GCHD if there is an exposure of COVID-19 at the pool.
- Limited Swim Time: If maximum occupancy is reached, Residents will be limited to 2-hour swim time. This will be monitored through the check-in time at the gate. "First in, First out" policy.
- **No Parties:** During this current phase, there will be no parties until further notice.
- Practice Physical Distancing: Practice "Social Distancing" of 6 feet in all areas of the pool deck.

- Scheduled Cleaning: During the 10-minute pool break conducted every hour, SC Pool Staff will conduct scheduled cleaning.
- No Lost and Found: Any items left in the pool area will be discarded at closing each day.
- As GCHD changes restrictions, these rules and guidelines may change.
